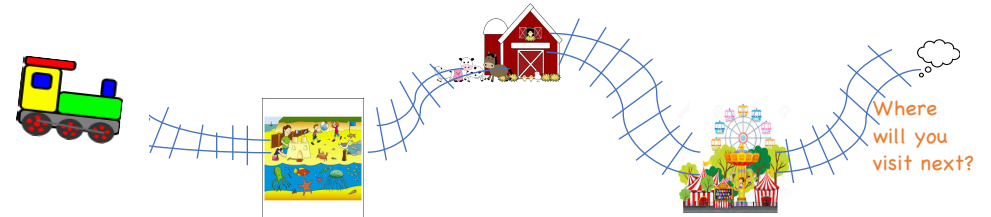
♪ Do you sound like
