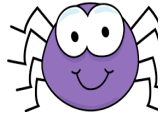




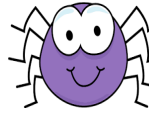
## Listen up!

## Let's Get Creative!

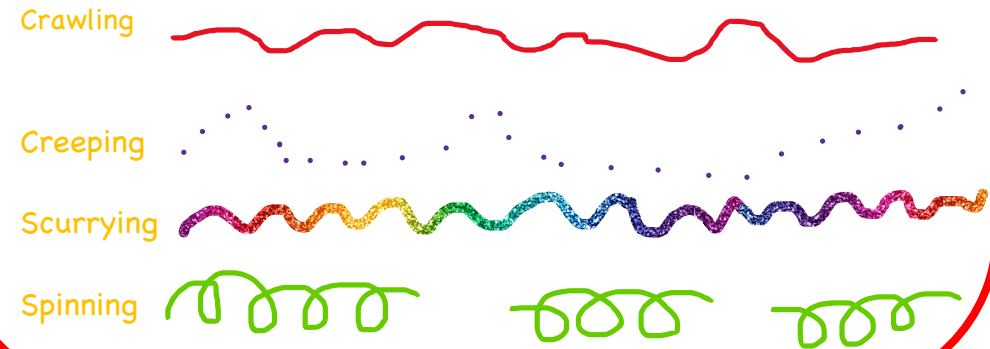


### Super Spider Sounds
